A- Vocabulary Related to traditional women activities



To take care of children: At home, mothers wash, feed, dress their children; they take care of their children.

To work a lot: Rural women do many things a day: they sweep the yard, fetch water from the river, cook food, take care of the family etc. So they **work a lot**.

To be strong: To have physical force.

Language function: Reporting someone's speech

- ➤ **Direct speech** → Mary said: "Rural women sweep the yard every day."
- ➤ Indirect speech → Mary said that rural women swept the yard every day.
- ✓ **Direct speech** → Koffi said: "I am a student."
- ✓ **Indirect speech** →Koffi **said that he was** a student.
