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**Language function:** Talking about the days of the week



Today is Wednesday. To know about the day, we ask:

**“What’s the day today?”**

To know the order of the days of the week,

The question is : **“What’s the first day of the week?”**

Answer: **“It’s Monday.”**

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**Language function: Asking and giving the date**



To say the date, you use the day, the month, an ordinal number and the year.

For example, we say: **“Today is Wednesday, April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020.”**

To ask the question about the date of today, we say: **“What is the date today?”**
