1. Read the text quickly and give its gist.

The 2018 FIFA World Cup Final was a football match that took place on 15 July 2018 to determine the winners of the 2018 FIFA World Cup. It was the 21st FIFA World Cup, a quadrennial tournament contested by the men's national teams of the member associations of FIFA. The match was played by France and Croatia, and held at the Luzhniki Stadium in

5 Moscow, Russia. It ended 4-2 in favor of France.

Before 2018, France 's only World Cup victory was 1998-though they had also reached the the final in 2006 — while Croatia were playing in their first World Cup final.

France won the match 4-2, having taken 2-1 lead during the first half on an own goal and penalty awarded by the video assistant referee (VAR), both first in a world Cup final. France

also became the second team in the 32-team World Cup to win all their knockout matches without any extra time or penalty shoot-out after Brazil in 2002. The final was watched by a global audience of 1.12 billion people on television and streaming platform.

The man of the match was Antoine Griezman of France and the referee was the Argentinian Néstor Pitana. 78,011 people were at the stadium and the weather was partly cloudy at

15 27°C (81°F) and the humidity was 51%.
