THE ROLE OF WOMEN

Women have always played a central role in society. They ensure stability, progress and long-term development of nations. In Africa, for example, 80 percent of the agricultural production comes from small farmers, most of whom are rural women. It is widely accepted that agriculture can be the factor of growth and poverty reduction in developing nations.

- 5 Women, notably mothers, play the largest role in decision-making about family meal planning and diet. They are the first caretakers of children and elders in every country of the world. International studies demonstrate that women hold the economy of families. They play a vital role by supporting their households and communities, by providing food and nutrition security and improving rural life.
- 10 Basic education is important to a nation's ability to develop human resources and to begin development. Most often, it is the mother in the family who urges children of both genders to attend and stay in school. The role of women in the urban and rural workforce has expanded exponentially in recent decades. However, they still have fewer opportunities than men worldwide.
