Every African woman exudes indescribable heavenly beauty without a wig. If our beautiful Ghanaian/African women are not ashamed of whatever hair they naturally have, if they are capable, in most cases, of growing long hair, why is it that nearly all of them these days publicly sport off- putting, synthetic or dead people's hair from Brazil, India, Philippines or Europe?

The argument that not all people are blessed with good, healthy abundant hair is valid. But if so, why is it that they do not then keep their hair low-cut, or cropped down to manageable, presentable shapes like older Asante women...

The fashionable cultural switching to artificial wigs has other negative implications.
