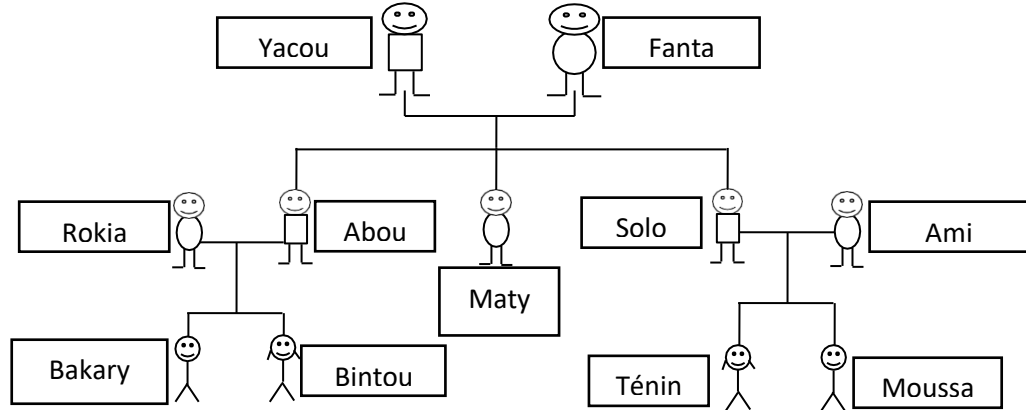

6. What relation is Fanta to Yacou?.....

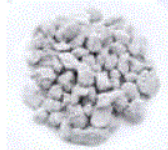
**EXERCISE 2 : (4pts)** Reponds par ‘‘true’’ si l'affirmation est vraie et ‘‘false’’ si elle est fausse
