International studies demonstrate that women hold the economy of families. They play a vital role by supporting their households and communities, by providing food and nutrition security and improving rural life.

10 Basic education is important to a nation's ability to develop human resources and to begin development. Most often, it is the mother in the family who urges children of both genders to attend and stay in school. The role of women in the urban and rural workforce has expanded exponentially in recent decades. However, they still have fewer opportunities than men worldwide.
